Class 5 Residential to Kilve Court

Dear Parents,

As you know, Class 5 will be visiting Kilve Court Residential Education Centre, near Bridgwater, for the Spring term residential visit.

The residential will begin on Wednesday 21st February, ending on Friday 23rd February. The children will take part in many educational, outdoor and adventurous activities during their stay, such as, abseiling, orienteering, and archery. There will be other team-building and fun activities during the two evenings we are there. The aim of the visit is for the children in Class 5 to develop their independence, confidence and to prepare them for the week long residential visit to Pinkery in Class 6. The activities are led by qualified instructors based at the education centre. Substantial hot meals are provided for breakfast, lunch and dinner and snacks are provided regularly between activities.

The trip will cost in the region of £135 per child (to be confirmed as we are awaiting a quote for transport) and should be paid to the school office. You may pay the cost in instalments (see instalment card) or as one lump sum. I will send out a letter with the confirmed price as soon as it is determined. I will also send out further information on what to pack etc. in January.
