the undoubted king with his gleaming gold crown.

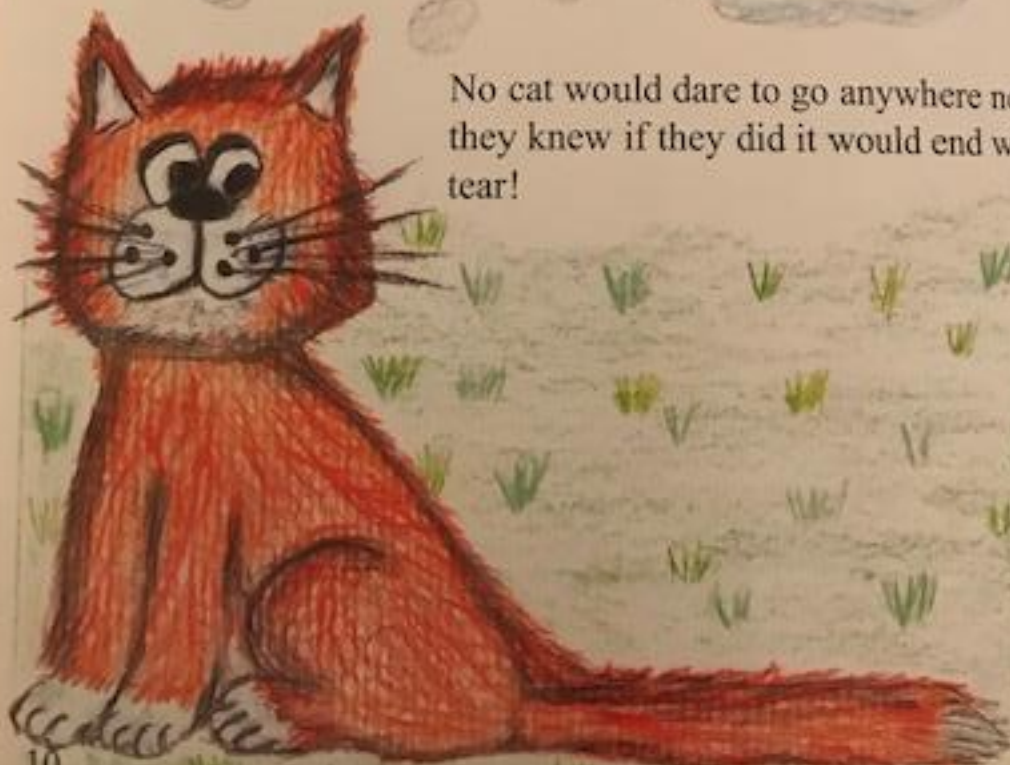

tear!





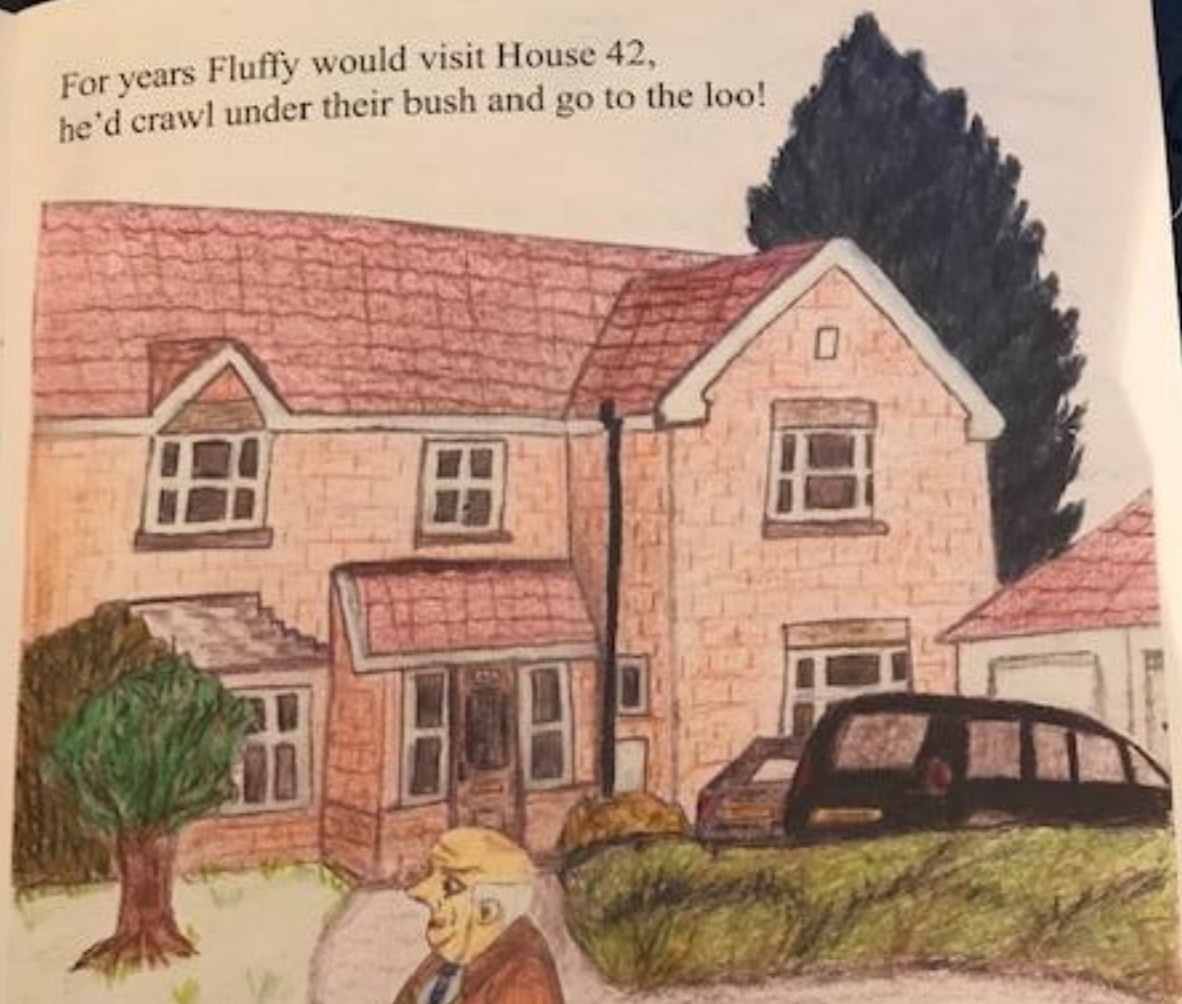
His fur was crimson like a roaring red fire,

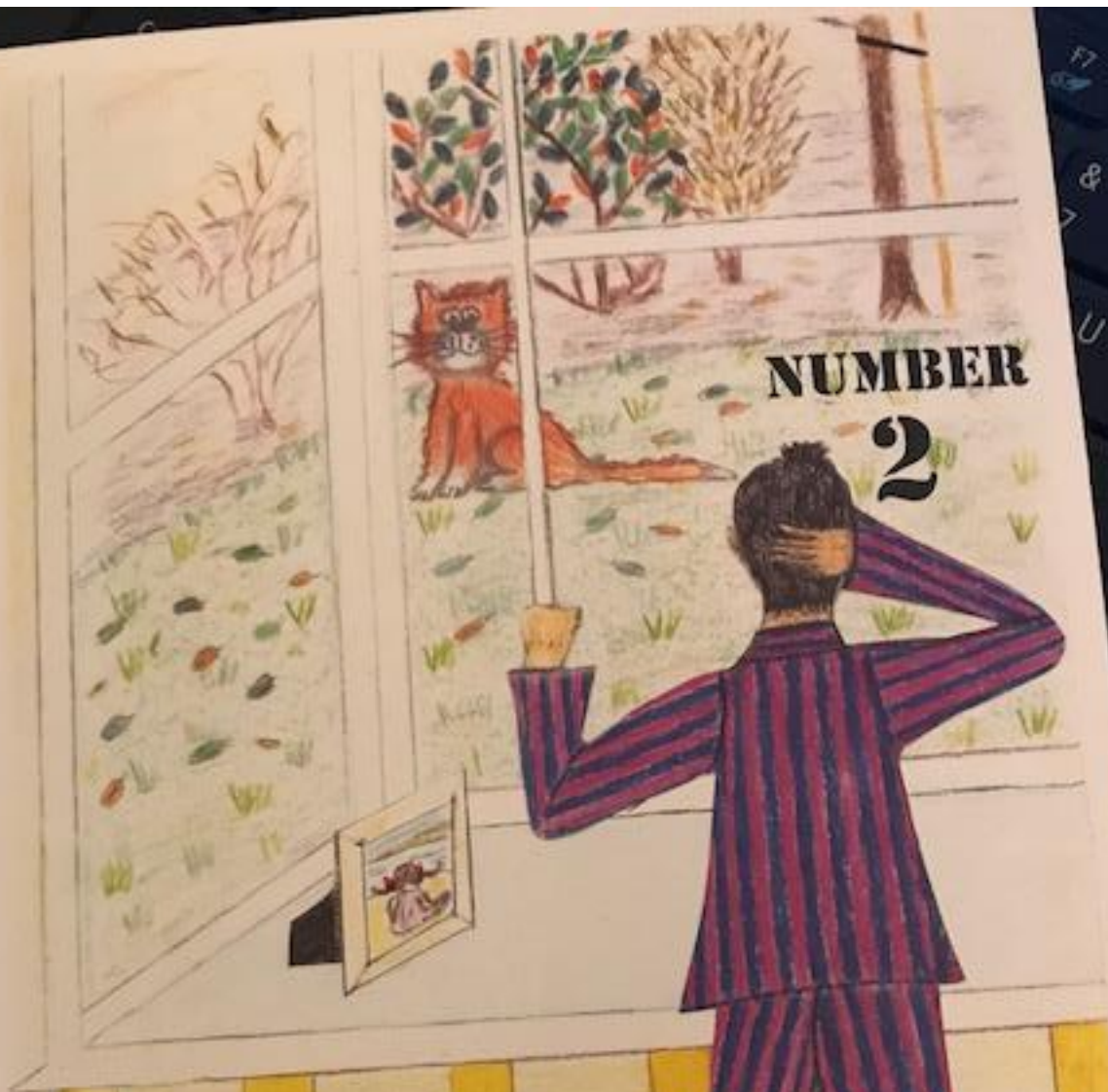

on the neighbours lawn was a fresh number two.

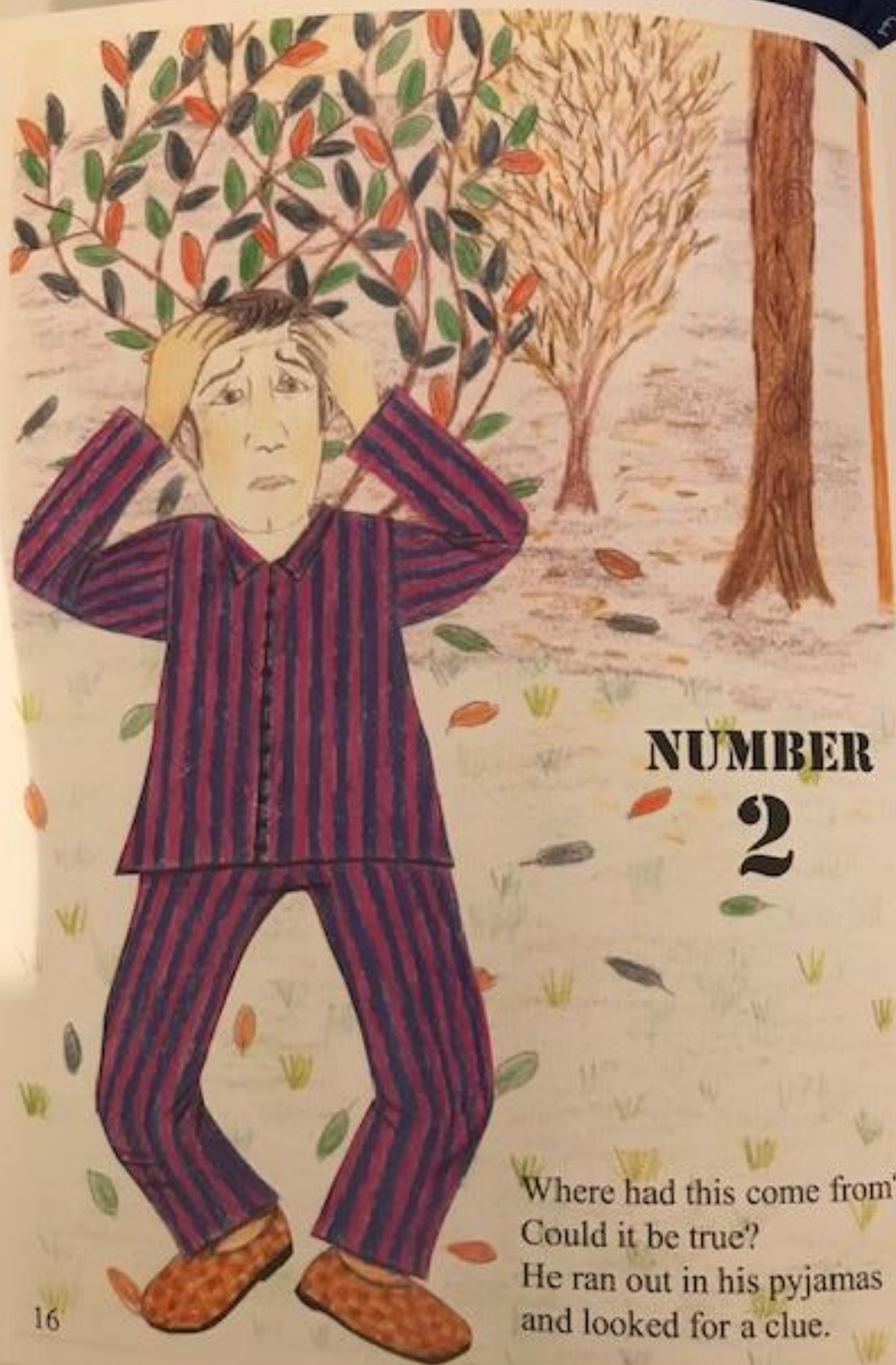

and studied with care.



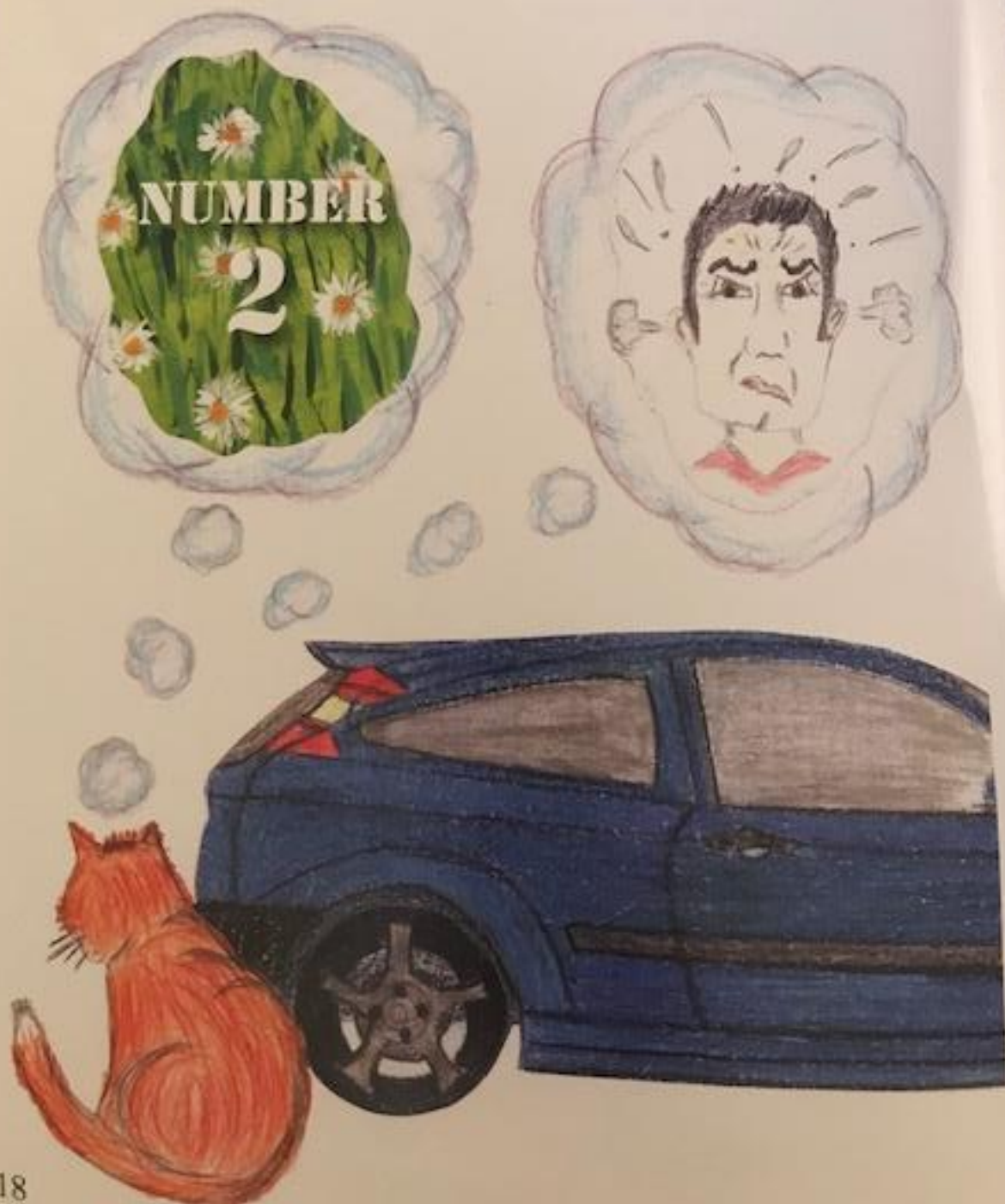
And there on the grass was a

RED HAIR!**



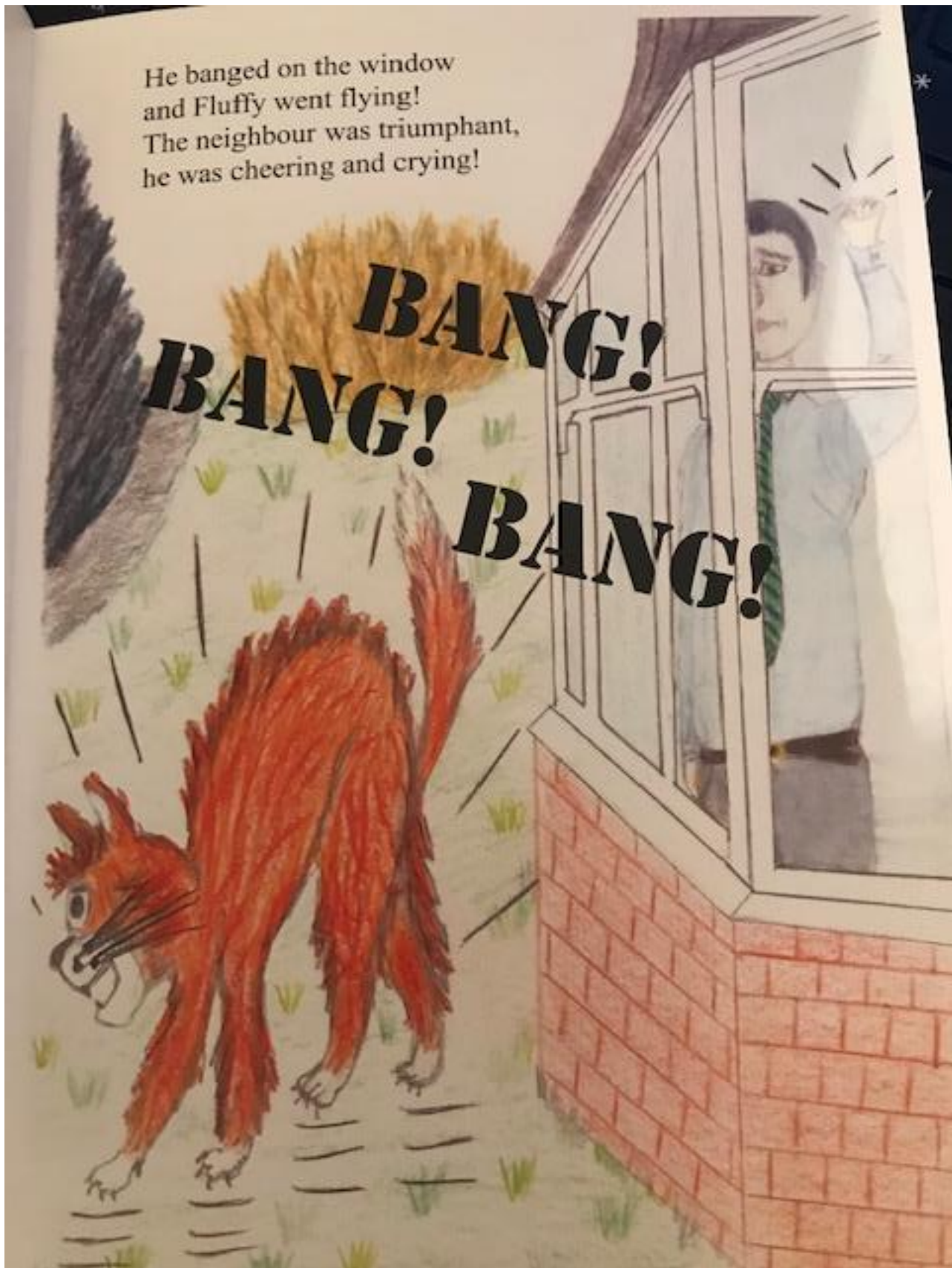
Who was the culprit?

he was cheering and crying!


BANG!
