## Rewards and Consequences:

- <u>Good behaviour</u>, <u>a positive learning mindset</u> and/or <u>excellent work</u> will be rewarded with a **house point** and being moved up to 'great effort' or 'outstanding' on the classroom chart.
- <u>Awards for Excellence</u>: Golden Certificate, Letter from the Headteacher, and Learning Mindset award.
- It is expected that you work hard and try your best in all your school work. You may be asked to <u>re-do poor work</u> at break or lunchtime.
- <u>Poor attitude or behaviour</u> will result in a warning. If poor behaviour continues, an appropriate amount of play time may be lost. If necessary, pupils who are poorly behaved may be sent out of class to speak to the Headteacher.
- <u>Whole Class Reward</u>: Fill up the <u>Strawberry Chart</u>, and the whole class will be rewarded with an extra playtime or a fun activity, to be chosen by the class teacher!

## <u>Homework:</u>

- All homework set will be handed out on Thursdays and should be handed in by the following <u>Friday</u>. If homework is not handed in on time, children may miss some playtime in order to catch up.
- Homework will include: daily reading and keeping up to date with your Reading Log; a weekly Mathletics task or Maths worksheet; weekly reading on Bug Club/times tables on Times Tables Rockstar and spellings for the weekly tests.
- If you find the homework too tricky, we are happy to help. Remember to ask for help **before** the due-date. All homework will be posted on Google Classroom weekly.

# <u>Equipment needed:</u>

- PE Kit- please wear this to school on PE days.
- Reading Book and Reading Log everyday!
- **Pencil Case** -required. It <u>must</u> **fit easily in your tray** and will stay in school. You will be given a school pencil, blue handwriting pen and purple pen. You may bring your own colouring pencils and felt tips. No biros.

## <u>Equipment Storage:</u>

- Coats and kits on your peg in Practical Area.
- Bookbags in the tubs in the classroom.
- Packed lunch boxes **neatly** placed on Trolley under shelter.
- No rucksacks unless you cycle/walk regularly. This is a health and safety issue- there is very little space and tubs which overflow with large rucksacks lead to trip hazards on the floor. Please respect this rule for the safety of all pupils.
- Reading Books and Reading Logs in your tray in class; remember to take these home at the end of each day.

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#### Daily Routines:

- Doors open at 8.50 a.m. Please enter the classroom quietly, hand in letters / homework and follow instructions on the board;
- Register and morning prayer promptly at 9am. Quietly complete warm up task until lesson begins;





- Lunch at 12.20pm- wash hands guietly, followed by prayer. Please respect Lunch Supervisors and follow any instructions given.
- End of lunch at 1.25pm enter classroom guietly and read silently;
- End of the day 3.30pm -Please leave your desk tidy. Ensure you take home your reading book and reading log, and any other equipment on relevant days, such as swimming kit, water bottle, homework etc.

#### Reminders:

- Spelling tests will be every Thursday.
- Please remember to take kits for any clubs to school and take them home afterwards for • washing.
- In general, if you are well enough to be in school, you are well enough to partake in PE/Swimming. Exceptions will be made in certain circumstances with an accompanying letter from a parent.
- Remember the Classroom Charter. You helped to set these expectations at the start of the year, so you should respect them and follow them every day. The class rules are there to keep you safe and happy, and to ensure things are fair for everyone.
